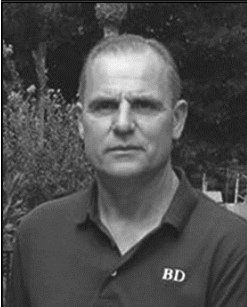

The Athletic Hall of Fame is proud to announce the induction of **Bob Drummond**. Bob played basketball for the Bulldogs from 1972 to 1975 controlling both the offensive and defensive boards on the court. He was a member of the 73 West Division Championship team and garnered All Northern status his Junior and Senior years. He scored over 1000 points in his career. Bob scored 55 points against archrival Lisbon setting a new Northern Athletic Conference for points in one game which had been set by Canton's Hal Cohen.

The Athletic Hall of Fame is proud to announce the induction of the **1995 Girls Softball team**. This team was the first girls team in any sport to make it to State finals. Led by Coach Al Minkler, he molded this young team into winners. After losing their first game of the season they reeled off 19 straight wins. Using a winning combination of defense, offense and pitching, the young Bulldog girls won their division, Section 10 and the regional championship in States before losing to powerful Afton in the semi-finals. The camaraderie that Coach Minkler taught these girls 20 yrs ago still exists today.



The Athletic Hall of Fame is proud to induct it's first team ever to win a State Championship, the **2015 Girls Varsity Basketball team**. The team posted a 24 -2 record season under Coach Rob Powers. The team was led by an array of skilled players who were able to come in at anytime to help win their games. The Bulldogs won the D West Title and the Section 10 D West Regional title before heading to Troy where they beat the Panama Girls team on Saturday and the South Kortright Girls Team on Sunday becoming Heuvelton Central Schools first State Championship Team ever.

Community Service Award

The Heuvelton Alumni Association is pleased to announce that **Derry Loucks '67** will be the recipient of the "2015 HAA Community Service Award". Derry is a graduate of HCS Class of 1967. From 1967-1969, He attended Mohawk Valley Community College in Utica and also took Business Management courses in the mid eighties at both SUNY Canton and Potsdam College. From 1969-1972 Derry served in the U.S. Air Force. He was stationed in Texas, Massachusetts and Spain as a communications center specialist. In 1972-1973, he served with the U.S. Armed Forces Network. Derry was a radio personality serving all U.S. Military personnel in Spain and Naval ships located in Mediterranean Sea. Some highlights include interviewing actor Lee Marvin and actress Raquel Welch as well as radio personality Wolfman Jack, and music group Blood, Sweat and Tears. In September 1973, Derry was honorable discharged as a Sergeant.

In October 1973, Derry began a 40 year career in radio with St Lawrence Radio Inc. WPDM/WSNN Potsdam. From 1973-1978 he was an on air disc jockey and 1979 to 1988 he was on air and also director of programming. In 1989 he was the Radio Sales Manager until 1998 when he became the Assistant General Manager until his retirement in Aug of 2013. Some highlights include interviewing singers Chris Deburgh and Jeannie C. Riley as well as actor Larry Linville (Major Frank Burns of tv show M.A.S.H), Dave Jennings of the NY Giants and Magician/Mentalist The Amazing Kreskin. Derry covered some major broadcast events including the resignation of President Richard M. Nixon, the Challenger Disaster of 1986 and the 9/11 Terrorist Attack.

Community Service Award

From 1985-2001, Derry served as Publicity Director of Edward I. Moses Walk/Run for Life which has reached the \$1,000,000 mark in donations to area cancer centers in St. Lawrence County. From 1981 to present Derry has run a total of 27,600 miles including numerous 5, 10 and 15 kilometer races, half marathons and 5 complete 26.2 mile marathons in Ottawa Ontario, Marine Corps Marathon in Washington D.C. as well as Marathons in Philadelphia PA and Burlington VT. From 1998 to present Derry Founded and was Director of the Hobble Gobble Prediction Run/Walk in West Potsdam which has grown to be the second largest north of Syracuse and has raised over \$123,000 for area charities. Derry has been married for 36 years to his wife Eileen. He has 4 stepchildren, Jack Mee of West Potsdam, Kathy Mee of Milan Michigan, Jeff Mee of Lisbon and Cynthia Mee Hayes of Baldwinsville, NY. Derry and Eileen have 9 grandchildren.

Distinguished Alumni Awards

The Heuvelton Alumni Association is pleased to announce that **Ken Lalonde, Class of '85** will be the recipient of a "2015 HAA Distinguished Alumni Award". After graduation Ken attended Canton ATC from 1985-87 majoring in Engineering Science. He then attended Clarkson University graduating in 1989 with a BS in Mechanical Engineering. Ken entered the defense industry upon graduation, working as a Project Engineer, focused on semiconductor manufacturing for Northrop Grumman Corp in Fishkill, NY. He moved to Syracuse and worked for GA Braun designing industrial washing equipment as a New Product Development Manager and soon thereafter was promoted to Engineering Manager. At Ingersoll Rand, he held a position of Manufacturing Manager where he managed plants in the production of components in the automotive and industrial sectors.

In 2001, he was offered the position as a Vice President of Engineering at Davenport Machine and moved to Rochester, NY. Even when he was working for others, Ken would go to work and perform as if it was his name on the building. He consistently gave his all. In 2002, the opportunity to buy Five Star Tool Company was presented to him and he ran with it. The deal was sealed in March, 2003 and he became sole owner of the then 38 year old business. His entrepreneurial spirit further developed and Five Star Tool continued to grow into a multi-faceted company. With 25 employees at the time Ken took ownership, it was focused on manual processes. Under Ken's leadership, Five Star Tool has pushed to improve its technical capabilities, emphasizing automation. The industries it serves includes aerospace, automotive, defense, firearms, industrial, medical and tobacco.

Ken's commitment to the company goes beyond profits. He has built the foundation so his employees aren't worried whether their jobs are in jeopardy as a result of mismanagement. He recognizes that the employees helped get the company where it is today. There is a focus on work-life balance at Five Star Tool, as Ken is mindful that his employees, like him, have families and personal lives.

Ken is married to Renee and they have two boys, Jacob (15) and Joshua (12). They live east of Rochester in Ontario, NY. As a family, they enjoy boating, snowmobiling, downhill skiing and traveling.

In 1974, Gordon graduated with a Masters Degree in Social Work at the University of Georgia. He worked as a Counselor for the Pennsylvania Department of Corrections from 1974-76. In 1976-1986, he served as Director of Youth Services, Family Service Society, Corning, New York. From 1986-1988, Gordon was the Clinical Director at St. Joseph's Hospital Alcohol and Drug Rehab in Elmira, NY and in then became School Social Worker for the Corning-Painted Post School District in Corning, NY until 2005.

Gordon married Cheryl Bracy in 1969. They have a son, Brian and daughter, Cori. and 3 grandchildren. Other activities include developing the Corning Area Youth Center. Gordon and Cheryl became National Disaster Mental Health workers and have worked in various disasters in Virginia, North Carolina, Texas and New York. They also have volunteered in local Red Cross activities in Corning, NY. Gordon has also maintained a Private Practice for a number of years.

Gordon and Cheryl started an Antiques and Collectibles business in 1996. Gordon buys, sells, collect and restore vintage woodworking tools, early farm wrenches and early farm machinery manuals. Gordon and Cheryl retired to Inverness, Florida in December, 2005 where they continue their Antiques and Collectibles Business. They enjoy travel and have visited Italy, Costa Rica, and Panama. They have visited many states including Hawaii and Alaska.


